

Matt Prior's laser vision passes batting test

Matt Prior ended the second day of the fifth test in spectacular form. Having returned from paternity leave, he put his Accuvision laser visioned eyes to good effect to post 131 not out and helped himself and Paul Collingwood to a record fifth wicket stand of 218 against the West Indies.
