Surgery & Aftercare

Lasik eye surgery is the most popular form of laser vision correction. The actual laser eye surgery itself takes between 5 and 30 seconds per eye. As the eyes are anaesthetised you do not feel anything (with the only side effects being slight discomfort, watery eyes and sensitivity to light, yet these do wear off very shortly after). Most patients can return to work and drive 48 hours after surgery.

A bandage contact lens is placed over the eye to protect it after surgery and you are also given eye drops and eye shields to sleep in over night. The following day you return to the clinic to have your bandage contact lenses removed and you are then booked in for a one week check up to monitor progress. Monitoring continues for the year and is included in the Accuwave treatment price.

Trans-Epithelial Surface Treatment

This unique Accuwave[™] 'no-touch' procedure enables laser correction, without creating a flap at the front of the cornea. The laser is used twice; first to carefully remove the epithelium from the surface of the treatment zone, leaving it smooth and regular. The second laser treatment alters the shape of the cornea so that sharp vision is achieved. The recovery time can be slightly longer but this Accuwave treatment plan is a particularly good for those that don't want the eye flap surgery, or for those who do high impact sports.
